Online training courses

In the context of online training courses, we process the following personal data:

- Basic data (first name/surname)
- Contact data ((private) address, mobile telephone number, land line telephone number, e-mail address)
- Company/organisation

Your personal data are processed only for providing online training courses (art. 6 para. 1 lit. b EU GDPR) or if there is a legal obligation to process the data (e.g. due to tax legislation) (art. 6 para. 1 lit. c EU GDPR).

Your consent to the data processing can of course also represent agreement in relation to data protection (art. 6 para. 1 lit. a EU GDPR). Before you grant consent, we clarify for you the purpose of the data processing and your right to withdraw your consent according to art. 7 paragraph 3 EU GDPR. We retain your data, as per statutory requirements, for 3 months after the end of the online seminar for free of charge courses, or for 10 years for fee-based courses; we delete the data as soon as they are no longer required for the purposes stated above or you have withdrawn your consent and there are no longer any statutory retention obligations.

In our company we make sure that your data are only available to the departments and persons who need these data to fulfil their contractual and statutory obligations.

We use the Gotowebinar web conference tools from Logmein Inc. and Skype for Business to provide our online training courses. Also here, we only collect the data necessary to hold the online training courses, data that you also provide during registration for the events.
